Clubs : tournament play will run from 12noon – 4.30pm.

Schools : tournament play will run from 1.30pm – 4.30pm (due to clashes with Junior Internationals and Small Schools Tournament, 1st/2nd or 3rd teams are warmly invited)

ENTRY FEES

Cost per team is £25. Deposit of £40 per club or school, refundable if team arrives on time, provides two umpires as requested and has numbered bibs or shirts. Please complete the attached entry form and send, with cheques, to arrive by Friday 7 March. Entries after this date cannot be accepted. Confirmation of entry may be obtained by phoning me and if your entry will not arrive on time please call by Friday 7 March to indicate entry details.

REQUIREMENTS

Each team provides two qualified umpires to officiate when their team is not playing. Each team should arrive at Fettes to be ready to play at the start time requested.

PRIZES

There are to be prizes for teams in a number of categories. Schools will be included in the tournament with the Club teams, but there will be a separate prize for the winning school. Tournament will be played for prizes of value to your club, university or school to help you next season – places on coaching courses, at the umpiring course, actual umpiring or coaching costs or visits and equipment can be won depending on matches won, goals scored etc. No actual cash ...! Tournament Referee's decision on prizes will be final.

Details

1. Confirmation of which pitches at Fettes will be made in week before tournament – e-mail me
2. Draw will only be given out on the day
3. Cancellation due to weather will be by 5pm on 14 March. Please give a number at which a club representative can be contacted on 14th 6-8pm in case of cancellation/alteration of venue.
4. All teams must follow lacrosse Scotland mixed league rules for each match - maximum of 18 in a squad, 12 –a-side on field, 3 male field players at any one time ... another man may be in goal if you wish. Squads may be larger than 18 for whole tournament. Additional tournament rules may be given on the day at Tournament Referee's discretion.
